

A One of a Kind

You don't have to book a chain
to get a stunning view.

Not a chain hotel kind of person? There is an alternative.

Tucked at the back of a modest home on Burlington's Lakeview Terrace is an intimate bed and breakfast. The sole guest room is a suite composed of a sitting room, bedroom, and bath. The bonus is a knock-out view. The aptly-named One of a Kind Bed & Breakfast is ideal for a lone guest or couple (the bed is a double) or for two friends: a sofa-bed opens into a second double. At rates of \$95 to \$140, it beats out the Hilton and Marriott, and discounts are available for weekly and extended stays. Owner Maggie Sherman serves an ample breakfast featuring Vermont cheeses, fresh-baked scones or muffins, and fresh fruit, all delivered to your door or served in the garden or dining room.

What other Burlington accommodation offers a chance to soak up the sunset from a tree swing perched over the lake — plus free wireless Internet? Sherman is a one-of-a-kind herself, a Southern-born artist and community arts educator. She steers guests to Burlington's attractions, including off-the-beaten-path destinations. It's not for everyone, perhaps, but for the chain-averse seeking a simple base from which to explore, the place is a find.
